As stipulated by § 2586 and following of the law nr. 89/2012 Sb., coll., Civil code of Czechia (Hereinafter referred to as "the contract") 1. Article I 1.1. The subject of this contract is taking of a horse specified bellow (hereinafter referred to as ",the patient"): Name: Sex: Race: Colour: Born: Other specifications: into care of the provider for the purpose of providing professional medical care to the patient, for the reason (hereinafter referred to as "the treatment"). 1.2. The customer declares that the patient is marked for slaughter and human consumption: YES/ NO 1.3. The customer has provided the so-called "Equine passport" concurrently with the patient: YES/NO 2. **Article II** 2.1. The provider agrees to, in accordance with terms agreed upon in this contract, provide veterinary care for the customers' patient and the customer agrees to pay for the services provided, within the same terms. This includes any auxiliary expenditures of the provider that might arise from veterinary care provision. 2.2. The customer declares, that they have been fully informed about the patients' health and the specifics of the treatment and explicitly agrees with any and all acts that will be made by the provider during said treatment, as well as with any additional treatment acts, that the provider will deem necessary for successful treatment. 2.3. The provider agrees to perform a professional treatment on the patient and to make every possible effort to cure the patient. The provider, however, does not guarantee the success of the treatment; even under aforementioned care, it is not possible to guarantee full recovery, or even survival, of the patient. Article III The contractual parties have agreed to a preliminary price of _____ Czech crowns, which the 3.1. customer will pay to the provider. The provider can demand payment in advance, even repeatedly during the treatment, up to the full amount of the preliminary price.

- 3.2. The aforementioned price includes the payment for all necessary professional care, the price of drugs and other veterinary supplements, material costs and costs of patient interment, including stabling and feed. The basis for the price is the provider's price list, which the customer had the chance to see before agreeing upon this contract.
- 3.3. The preliminary price is made on assumption. Its' finality is not guaranteed and additional, at the time of signing this contract unexpected, costs might apply. The customer agrees to pay said costs, if they arise.
- 3.4. If, during the treatment, a need arises for unexpected and unexpectable treatment actions, that will infer additional costs, and these costs will increase the price for more than 20 %, the provider must inform the customer of the price increase, with an explanation for the increase. The customer agrees, that they will in such event, send an agreement with the price increase or a demand for end of the treatment, via email, within the next 24 hours from the moment the provider has informed them about the increase. If the customer does not do so, it is assumed that they agree with the increased price.
- 3.5. The customer agrees to pay the final price to the provider, in accordance with final written billing, which the customer will receive from the provider after treatment. The customer agrees to pay the final price in cash, unless the parties specifically agreed otherwise. If any advance has been paid, it will be reflected in the final billing.
- 3.6. The customer takes into account that they will be required to pay the price as stipulated above, even in the case of unsuccessful treatment, or even death of the patient.
- 3.7. The customer agrees, that the information about the patient and/or biological waste might be used for study and scientific purposes.
- 3.8. If the customer is represented by a third party, the third party agrees to become a guarantor of the customers' commitments as stipulated in this contract, and specifically agrees to pay the above stipulated price in the case, in which the customer does not pay the price even after receiving a written demand with reasonable deadline for payment. The guarantee includes all the accessories of the price. The provider accepts the pledge of guarantee.

4. Article IV – Final provisions

- 4.1. This contract exists in two equal copies, that both count as original. Each party will be given one.
- 4.2. This contract is governed by the law of Czechia, and any provisions that are not explicitly agreed upon, are made within the legal stipulations of Czech law. Any legal cases arisen from this contract will be decided by Czech courts.
